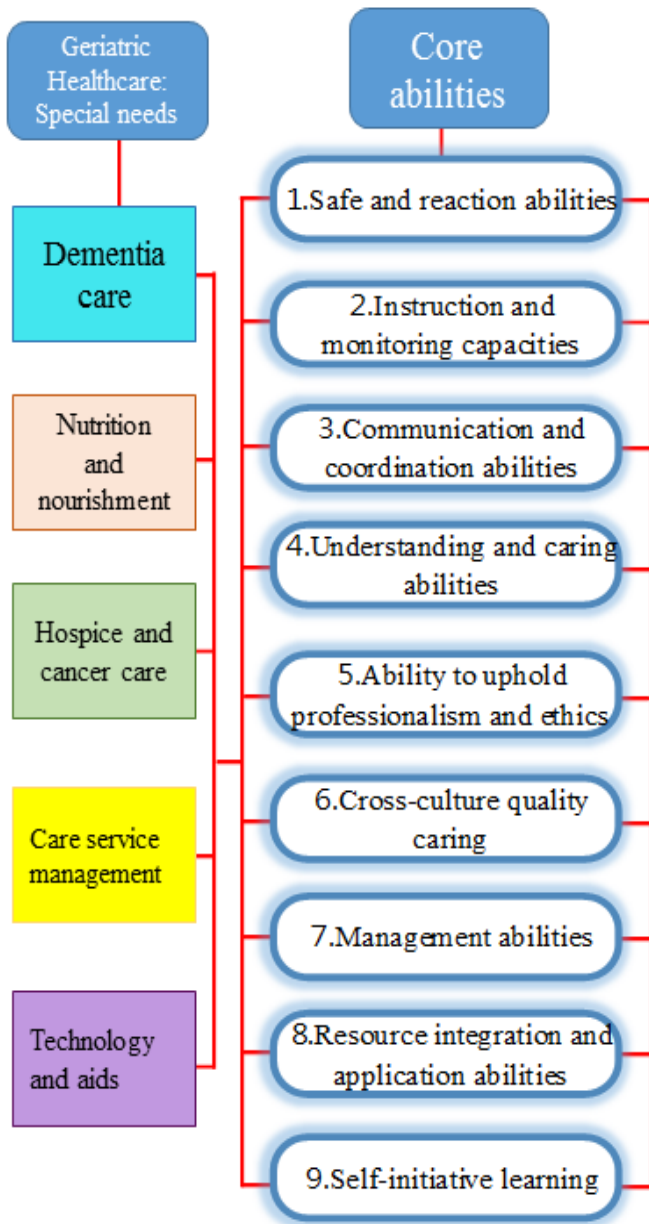


Gerontological Health Department: A course map
